Club Background

The Wolseley Car Club of New Zealand was formed in Christchurch in 1976 by a small group of enthusiastic Wolseley owners, who saw the potential and need for a Club representing this well-known marque in New Zealand. Shortly after formation, a set of rules was adopted, and the Club became an Incorporated Society.

There are now six branches in New Zealand, located in the following regions - Auckland, Bay of Plenty/Waikato, Manawatu, Nelson/Marlborough, Christchurch and Southern. Members are spread over the length and breadth of the country and cover a wide range of occupations and ages.

The New Zealand Club is affiliated to the Wolseley Register in England, and Wolseley Car Clubs in Queensland, New South Wales and Victoria, in Australia.

Models of Wolseley cars represented in the New Zealand Club cover everything from Veteran and Vintage models, 1930's Hornets and 'Series' cars, right through to

the last of the more modern front-wheel drive models.

Any person either owning or interested in Wolseley vehicles is eligible for membership of the Club. The initial membership subscription is only \$55:00. This is divided into two parts:

- A joining fee of \$15:00, and
- An annual subscription of \$40:00.

Ten dollars of the joining fee is for a spare parts levy, which is placed in an account used solely for the purchase of Wolseley spare parts and technical information, and to help provide a steady income to maintain and improve our spare parts and facilities. Spares held by the Club are sold to Club members only. Subscriptions fall due on 1 July each year.

The principle objective of the Club is to encourage the interest, use and preservation of Wolseley vehicles. To achieve this, we offer a number of services to members, which are explained on the rear of this leaflet.

Here's what we can offer Wolseley enthusiasts

REGULAR ACTIVITIES

All Branches run their own activities. Most Branches organise at least one activity each month; typically a run or rally to a place of interest. Sometimes the Branch will join with other one-make Clubs for outings, or will participate as a group in larger activities, such as the Annual All British Days. Often these are supplemented by an evening meeting, which could range from a demonstration or technical session to a film evening. In addition to this, some Branches run working bees every month at the Branch spare parts shed, where members are able to assist in sorting and storing parts, or can spend time looking for parts they need to keep their Wolseley on the road.

Wherever possible, Club activities are organised that will cater for the partners and families of members as well. It is accepted that some Club members may not always have their Wolseley on the road, so it is not necessary to always turn up to a Club event in a Wolseley.

The Club also holds a National Rally every two years (2010, 2012, etc.) which all members and their families are invited to participate in. These National Rallies alternate between the North and South Islands, with the 2010 Rally being held in the South Island.

MONTHLY NEWSLETTER

The Club produces its own newsletter. The 'Wolseley Word' is published every month, except December. The newsletter contains a list of coming activities for each Branch, reports on events held, and one or more technical articles such as a road test or information on repairs and maintenance. A 'Buy and Sell' column is always included, which is offered as a free service to members.

LIBRARY OF MANUALS, TECHNICAL INFORMATION, AND TOOLS

An extensive library containing workshop manuals, parts books, handbooks, and other technical information for all models is available free of charge to all members. If required, publications can be reproduced for a nominal charge.

A good selection of special service tools are also available for members to borrow.

SPARE PARTS SERVICE

The Christchurch, Manawatu, and Bay of Plenty / Waikato Branches each hold stock of used parts, which are available to financial members only. In addition to used parts, the Christchurch Branch stocks a huge selection of new parts and fast moving lines (gaskets, electrical, engine and suspension parts), which are available to all Club members at very competitive prices. Most new parts now held by the Club are listed as being no longer available at regular parts outlets throughout the country.

Stocks are increasing yearly, and the club is continually expanding its available spares to cater for a wider range of models. If an item is not held in stock, the Club will certainly endeavour to locate it. Overseas sources are often investigated, and some limited lines and reproduction parts are being re-manufactured for the Club.

ASSISTANCE AND FELLOWSHIP

One of the most important aspects of the Club is to provide a medium for enthusiasts with a common interest in Wolseley motor vehicles to meet each other, and share tips and useful information about the maintenance and repairs of their cars. This is made possible through all of the above services.
